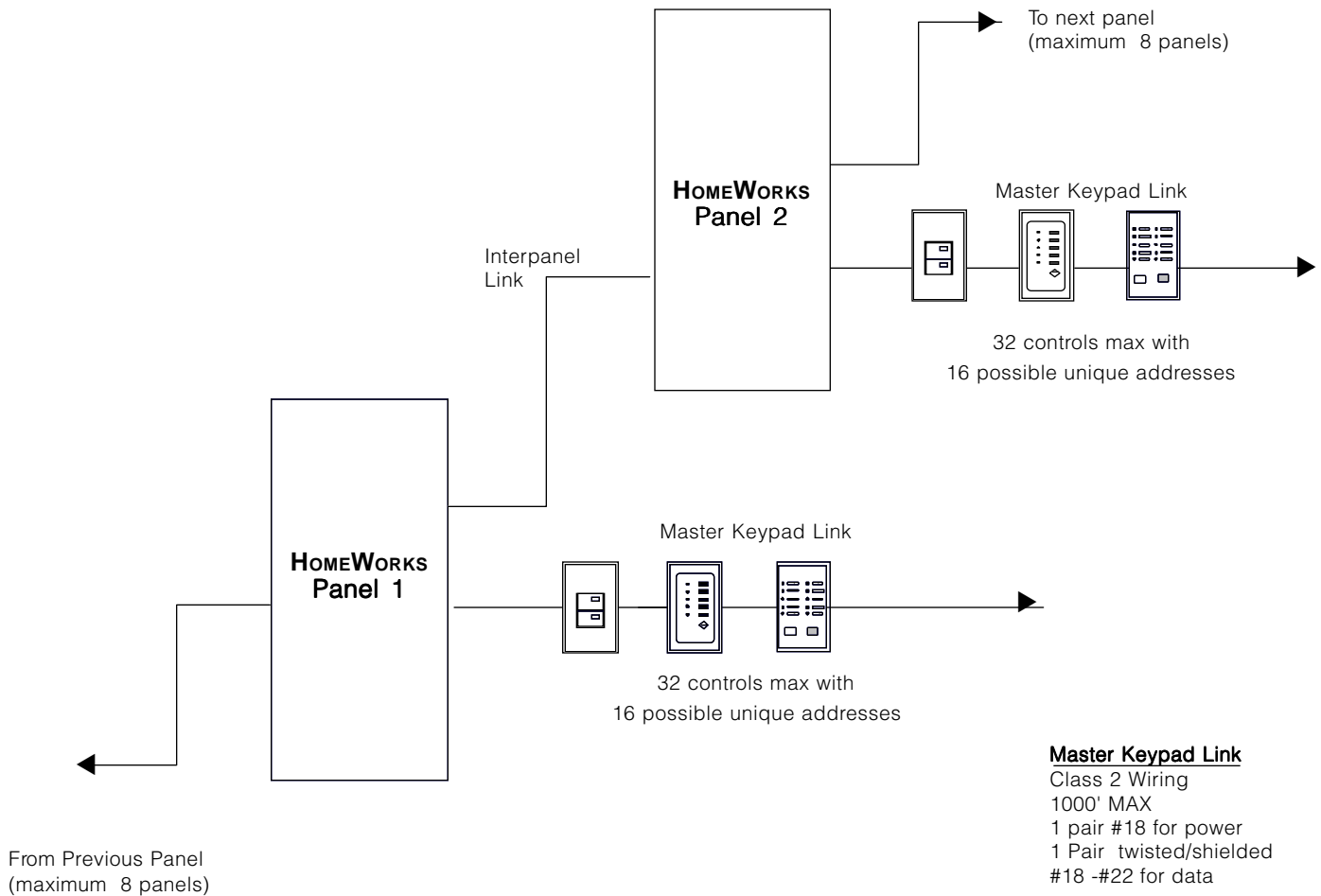


► System Wiring**



► Giving Master Keypads their Unique Address

For this address ↓

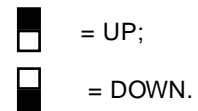
Each Master Keypad should have a unique system address (1-16). This identifies the keypad and enables it to communicate with the unit.

To give a Master Keypad its address, set switches 1 - 4 on the back of the unit as shown at right. Document your assignments by noting which keypad corresponds to which address.
