Key Features that will be coming soon to RadioRA 3

- 1) RadioRA 2 to RadioRA 3 project conversion (coming in the next release of the Lutron Designer software tool — rev 21.7)
- 2) Pair two RA3 Processors to create 1 system of up to 400 devices
- 3) SUNNATA RF Hybrid Keypads with both dimmer and keypad functionality all in one device
- 4) RadioRA 3 Outdoor Plug-In Switch coming in Spring 2022. Built to withstand the elements, the Outdoor Plug-in Switch provides on/off system control of plugged-in outdoor lights – like patio string lights, landscape lights, and holiday lights – as well as small pumps and motors like those for ponds, fountains, or decorative inflatables.
